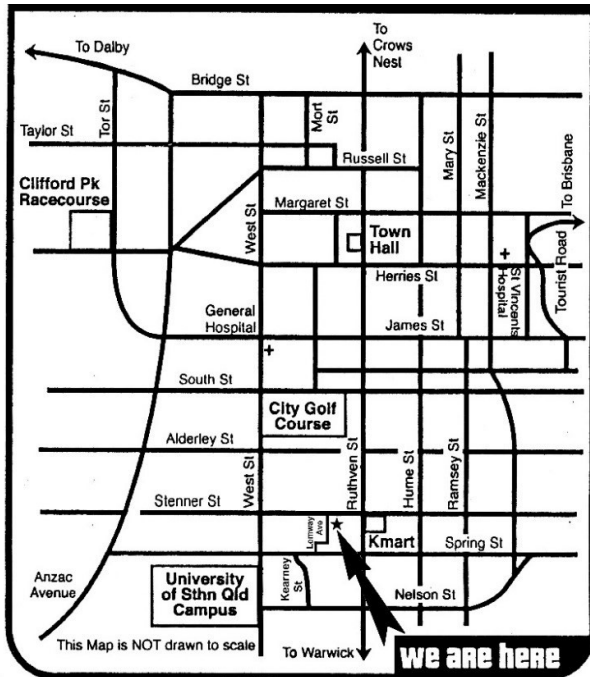


Where we are in Toowoomba:

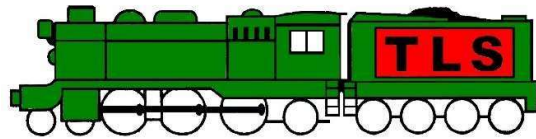

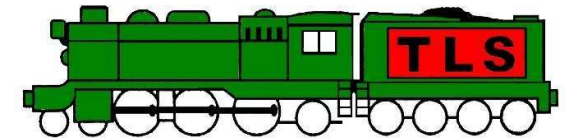

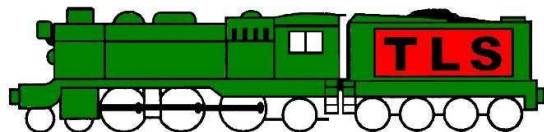
Toowoomba Live Steamers Inc.

Aim: To bring together people who have an interest in the building and operation of model/ miniature mechanical devices, predominately powered by steam. e.g. locomotives, traction engines, etc.

Meetings: Monthly meetings are held at the Club Shed at the southern end of Lemway Park, Lemway Avenue, Kearney Springs.

Prospective members and visitors are most welcome to attend.

Membership: Membership is open to any persons over the age of 14 interested in the aims of the organisation and pay the annual membership. Membership is subject to approval by the Management Committee. Application Forms are available from the Secretary. Prospective members and visitors are always welcome to come and have a chat.



Miniature Steam Railway

Our History: The club was formed in 1973 operating on land where the current Springs Garden World on Spring Street exists. From 1996 until 2016 the track was located at the Kearney Springs Historical Park.

During 2016/2017 the track was relocated to Lemway Park, Lemway Avenue, Kearney Springs and has been operating from this site since October 2017

What you see today is the result of many thousands of hours effort from hard working members, and the support of the Toowoomba Regional Council in the massive task of preparing the earthworks and drainage for the track, and the station and club shed buildings.

Our Site: The track meanders its way through Lemway Park through areas of trees and shrubbery mostly native to the area and beside cycling and pedestrian pathways. Picnic, playground, free BBQ and toilet facilities are available within Lemway Park.

Adequate parking is available.

Our Miniature Railway's Features: The railway consists of a 5 inch (127mm) and 7 ¼ inch (184mm) dual gauge railway track. The mainline is approximately 900m in length with a passing loop at the station and in-and-out spur line to the maintenance area, turntable and steaming bays.

Our Engines: Our Club's and members' model locomotives consist of steam, diesel, diesel-electric, and electric powered units. Some members also have model traction engines, and the park has an adequate area to accommodate these.

Our Resources: The construction, operation and maintenance of the railway is carried out voluntarily by the members. Club expenses include coal for model steam locomotives, maintenance of track infrastructure, public liability insurance. Our revenue is limited and comes by way of public train ride fares, private hire events, members' subscriptions and occasional grants (e.g. various community benefit funding programs).

The Toowoomba Regional Council funded and constructed the new earthworks, drainage and buildings for our recent relocation to Lemway Park.
